How We Do It

Standard AMAC membership includes:

- Staff with specialized skills -- accessible media production/braille/e-text/audio, technical support, assistive technology training, legal and compliance support
- Access to software to produce, track, store and deliver media
- Technical staff to maintain servers and backup files
- Assistive technology software that provides students with accessible media files
- Training and technical support staff to assist students
- Tracking distribution of alternate media to maintain copyright compliance
- Tracking DSS office activities, including student accommodations
